How Does 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten Work?

- Register At the Library or online, starting January 5, and take home your first reading log.
- Track Your Reading Each time you read a book with your child, fill in a circle on the reading log.
- Show us Your Reading Logs When you reach 25 books, bring in your reading log, and get a small prize! At 500 books, you get a really cool tote bag for carrying all those books. And at each 100-books mark, you get a "100 books!" sticker.
- Read More Books! When you get all the way to 1000, you'll receive a free book.
